28 states urge UN to report on human rights situation in PH

Twenty-eight in the Philippines Human Rights Mission have urged amid allegations of chelle Bachelet to the United Nations to take further action on the human rights situation in the Philippines and to present it to the pines.

council's 44th session "to be followed by an enhanced interactive dialogue."

The council, which is expected to vote on the said resolution in the coming days, is currently on its 41st session.

The draft resolution also asked the Philippines to "take all necessary measures to prevent extrajudicial killings and enforced disappearances" as well as to conduct "impartial investigations and to hold perpetrators accountable in accordance with international norms and standards including due process and the rule of law."

The draft resolution also asked the government to co-operate with Bachelet's office and the council's mechanisms "by facilitating country visits" as well as prevent or refrain "from all acts of intimidation or retaliation."

The draft resolution likewise recalled the "repeated expressions of concern" coming from Bachelet herself and the council's special procedure mandate holders about a human rights situation in the Philippines and to present it to the pines.

 - 3. National Bureau of Investigation Clearance of Mrs. Kizzielyn R. Anzures (Annex C);

- GAB was voluntary committed to the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Region 4 - Calabarzon and said government agency has consented to his adoption. Attached herewith as Annex "F" is the photocopy of the Affidavit of Consent to Adoption issued by Annie E. Mestela, OIC-Regional Director of the DSWD Field Office-IV.
- The DSWD has allowed the placement of the child/adoptive in the custody of the petitioner spouses in accordance with Republic Act No. 8552, articles 163 and 184 of the Family Code, Executive Order No. 20, and the adoption Policy of the DSWD. Attached herewith as Annex "G" and "H" are photocopies of the Pre-Adoption Placement Authority dated 15 August 2018 and petitioner's picture with the child/adoptive.

Self-employed professionals exempted from paying business permit fees for clinics, offices

The government has harmonized the taxes and other fees that self-employed professionals such as doctors, accountants and lawyers pay to local government units to cut red tape.

In a statement, the Department of Finance said Local Finance Circular (LFC) 1-2019 signed by Finance Secretary Carlos G. Dominguez III on June 12 was aimed at "ensuring a fair, uniform and

proper implementation of tax laws and in line with ongoing efforts to streamline government transactions to further improve the ease of doing business."

In particular, it exempted self-employed professionals from payment of business permit fees for clinics and offices.

"While professionals still need to secure business permits from LGUs, such boards empowered by law to supervise and regulate professions," the DOF said.

"LGUs, however, the office or clinic of

may impose a local business tax on professionals if they are verified to be engaged in selling, trading or distributing goods of whatever kind or involved in trade and other business activities that do not constitute the practice of their profession. In this case, the LGU can

the concerned professional," it added, citing LFC 1-2019. Finance Undersecretary Antonette C. Tionko said LFC 1-2019 was issued following complaints lodged by self-employed professionals citing "improper imposition of local taxes, fees and other charges by LGUs."

Hontiveros hits 'made in China' report on Recto Bank incident

Senator Risa Hontiveros blasted what she called a "made in China" report indicating that the Filipino fishermen, who were hit and left at sea by a Chinese vessel, shared accountability in the incident.

"Tayo na nagsa ang binangga, hindi tinulungan at iniwanan halos mamatay sa gitna ng dagat ng isang dayuhang sasakyang na dapat ay wala sa ating teritoryo, tapos tayo pa ang may sala?" Hontiveros said in a statement last July 5.

"This is clearly a case of victim-blaming. Parang may nag-hit-and-run sa nakaparada

PH factories produce fewer goods for 6 months in a row

The bad news was through Volume of ity (Neda), remained the continuing decline of factory output which fell for a sixth straight month in May.

The good news—the country's chief economist said it's not a cause for concern because easing inflation augurs well for the manufacturing sector.

In its Monthly integrated Survey of Selected Industries (Missi) report, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) said volume of production of goods last May declined by 4 percent year-on-year, a sharp reversal of a 13 percent growth posted in 2018.

Monthly production, measured development Author-

Production Index or VoPI, has been falling since December 2018 although the rate of decline last May was not as bad as last April's which showed a 14.3 percent fall in manufacuring output.

"Despite these negative figures, we note a positive devel-

opment," said Socio-economic Planning Secretary Ernesto M. Pernia, referring to stock market figures that showed more manufacturing firms gaining than losing.
